

A new standalone toilet was identified as a key priority in our Open Space Plan 2024-2034. The planning process has involved a site audit to determine the most suitable location, which considered access, service location, existing trees and crime prevention through environmental design (CPTED) principles. Two location options were presented for community consideration. The final location preferred by the community is shown on the adjacent plan.

FAQs

Where has the need for a toilet at Warradale Park Reserve come from?

A new public toilet is planned for Warradale Park Reserve, recommended in the City of Marion Open Space Plan. The toilet supports visitation to the reserve, tennis club and playground.

What will the toilet include?

The toilet will be approximately 2.5m x 2.5m with a single accessible cubicle with a change table and wash basin. The materiality and finishes will complement the existing reserve facilities including the tennis club and playground. The toilet will have an external security light which will be dimmed to avoid glare.

What times will the toilet be open?

The toilet will be open 7 days a week during daylight hours 7am-7pm.

How will the toilet be cleaned and maintained?

The toilet will be cleaned by contractors employed by the City of Marion and maintained on a regular basis.

Will the toilet be safe?

The proposed toilet location has been selected based on community feedback and ensures passive surveillance from passing foot and vehicular traffic. The toilet will automatically lock at 7pm each night.

When will the toilet be installed?

The toilet will be installed this financial year 2025/26.

Who was consulted?

A postcard with project information and a website link to the survey was sent to all local residents within 400m of the reserve. Further information about the consultation is available on the Making Marion website:
