

This is an Easy Read book.




Easy Read uses simple words and pictures.

We thought about what we had already done well.




We thought about things we plan to do to help the whole community feel healthy and well.

What we will do



We will help people with disability take part in sport, movement and play.



We will make it easier for people with disability to use places where council serves or sells food.



We will make it easier to get information about our activities and services.



We will help people in the community connect with other support organisations.



We will share good stories about people with disability with the community.



We will do better planning so everyone can use council buildings, outdoor spaces and toilets.



We will make it easier to use the council website.



We will make sure council is kind and respectful to people with disability.



We will help people with disability join and lead arts and culture activities.



We will ask people with disability

- for ideas and opinions on things council does



- to help council make decisions.



We will make sure people with disability are treated with respect when they work or volunteer for council.



We will make it easier for people with disability to

- tell council what it does well



- make a complaint about things that are unsafe in the community.



We will think about how to support people with disability when there is a community emergency.



We will think about things in the community that people with disability might need in the future.



For example

- services



- buildings



- outdoor spaces.

- make things easy for everyone to use



- work with others to support people with disability



- remember that people can have many needs.
